

# HOPE BEYOND DISPLACEMENT



The FAWCO Target Project

FAWCO Member Clubs selected HBD as the 2017-2019 Target Project as part of the **Target Program: Education - Empowering Women and Girls Through Knowledge and Skills**. Together, the FAWCO community supports this project through awareness and fundraising.

**Collateral Repair Project (CRP)** is located in Amman, Jordan, temporary home to hundreds of thousands of Iraqi and Syrian **refugees, living in urban settings, not camps**. It serves a community of people with diverse backgrounds, religions, and nationalities, who have fled their home countries due to violence. Every year CRP provides hundreds of families emergency assistance and offers numerous activities and learning opportunities to help refugees begin rebuilding the communities they lost after fleeing their home countries.

Displacement, loss of status and control over life choices, and the fact that **most refugees are not legally allowed to work**, all contribute to a sense of hopelessness and lack of empowerment, particularly for women. They are forced to negotiate new and difficult roles, but are hindered by a lack of confidence to affect change and commonly face increased risks due to negative coping strategies they or their spouses adopt which contribute to family violence.

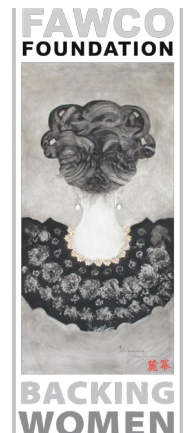
## Hope Beyond Displacement addresses four pressing issues identified in close consultation with the women CRP serves:

1. Ensuring better educational support for their children
2. Accessing sources of income through vocational training
3. Better managing the threat of violence in their families
4. Learning and developing leadership and advocacy skills.

The FAWCO Foundation's Backing Women Fundraising Campaign supports the Target Project: Administering funds raised by clubs at local club and regional events; Raising money through sales in their Backing Women Boutique, raffles and auctions; Conducting giving campaigns, like matching grants.
